Gordon is the subject of a cover feature in the current Alumni Magazine...Speaking of the Alumni Magazine, the Council for Advancement of Support of Education (CASE) recently awarded it a regional "Honorable Mention" for full-color alumni magazines. Gettysburg was the only liberal arts school to place in the category...On May 20, the Alumni Board of Directors will present *Scott Kintzing '74*, *Joyce Wessel Raezer '75*, *Stephen Steinour '80* and *Sandra Ulsh '75* with the 2006 Distinguished Alumni Awards...The women's lacrosse team is No. 1 in the Division III rankings thanks to an undefeated regular season and Centennial Conference Championship. The Bullets will not compete in the NCAA Championships. The men's lacrosse team will host the Centennial Conference Championships on May 5 & 7 as the top seed. The Bullets are ranked No. 3 nationally with a 14-1 record.

STEP UP TO THE PODIUM: Gettysburg College's latest digital initiative is "Podium," which will bring college happenings to your eyes and ears through "podcasting."
