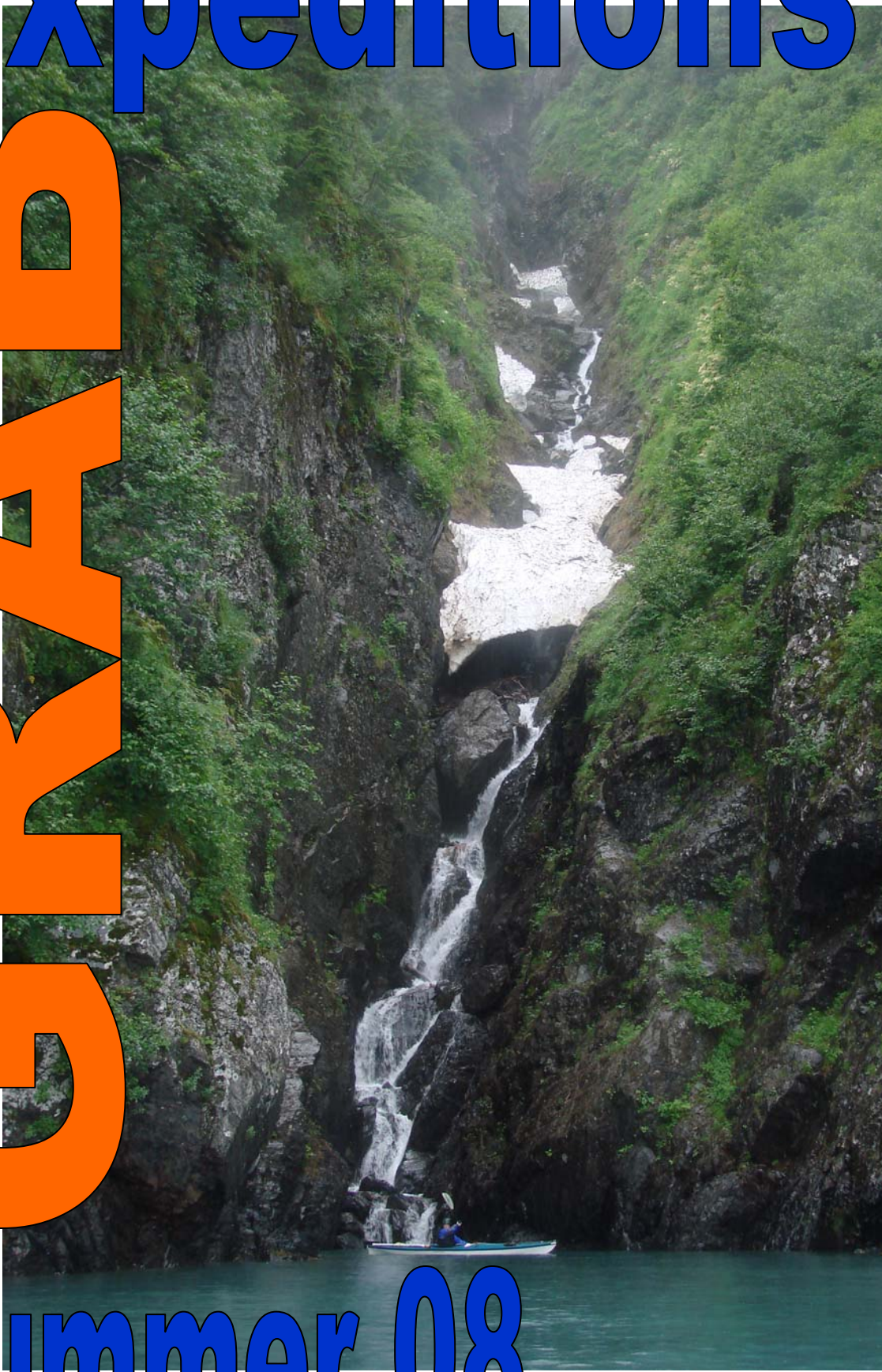

Backpacking Scotland

May 22-June 1, 2008

\$1395.00

The group will rendezvous in Glasgow for two days and then backpack along the West Highland Way for eight additional days. You will cover eight to ten miles a day along this historic trail while also experiencing a few side trips up a number of the Monroes—peaks over 3000 feet—with the final capstone hike to the summit of the notable Ben Nevis. At the end of the day on the trail, enjoy a warm cup of soup in a local pub with some of the other Scottish walkers. The group will visit Fort William prior to returning to Glasgow.

Trekking Tuscany

May 24-June 1, 2008

The trek of Tuscany will begin in the small town of Montepulciano and continue to Siena. As the group treks 10-12 miles a day, you will experience the pecorino cheeses of Pienza, the hot springs of Bagno Vignoni, the Brunello wines of Montalcino, the 12th century Sant' Antimo abbey, Cyprus trees, rolling hills, and the Duomo and the Piazza del Campo of Siena. The group will conclude with a train ride back to Rome for their final evening. The group will stay in 3 star hotels each evening and during the day while you trek, your luggage will be transferred.

Sea Kayaking Alaska

July 16-July 26, 2008

The group will begin at the Earth B&B located in Anchorage, Alaska. We will be transported to the small town of Whittier where we will be outfitted by Prince William Sound Kayak Company. The first day of this 70 mile journey will begin with a charter boat ride to the Culross Passage which is at the southern end of the Collegiate Glaciers. Whales, calving glaciers, bald eagles and vast expanses of wilderness are all part of this self contained journey.

Backpacking Olympic NP

July 25-August 3, 2008

After experiencing an evening at Pikes Place in downtown Seattle, the group will begin their journey via a ferry ride to the Olympic National Park. This backpacking trip will take you up the Elwa River and to some of the most spectacular alpine meadows and snow fields. The group is self contained and will camp each night on the trail. The day to day mileage will be determined by the group, but know that regardless how far you travel, you will only see a sliver of the park's 922,000 acres of wilderness.

Trekking Austrian Alps

September 4-14, 2008

\$1440.00

The trip will begin in Mozart's hometown of Salzburg, Austria. On the morning of our third day, we will take a shuttle to the base of the Dachstein region where we will then climb upward into the Alps. Day in day out we will experience alpine pastures, cows and bells, breathtaking exposure followed by evenings in the quintessential mountain huts. Here you will have access to showers, brats, goulash, and a bed in the common sleeping quarters. Trek 7-10 miles a day with just your clothing and couple other necessities. And if you plan it right, you can hit Oktoberfest the next weekend in Munich, Germany.
