Kendlehart

A letter addressed to “General Erley” (Jubal Early) from Kendlehart (presumably David Kendlehart) informing him that the citizens of Gettysburg are unable furnish the supplies demanded (listed above the letter), but that the citizens of the town will be required to furnish what they can and that stores will be required to open. Dated 26 June 1863.
