CAMP DIRECTOR



Devin O'Neill is entering his seventh season as Head Coach of the men's soccer program at Gettysburg. Over the last six seasons, the Bullets have accumulated a record of 60-39-14 and advanced to the postseason five

times. Under O'Neill's tutelage, eight Bullets have been named all-region by the National Soccer Coaches Association of America, while 23 have been named All-Centennial Conference, including a dozen first-team selections. O'Neill holds a USSF "A" license along with an NSCAA Premier Diploma. He has extensive youth soccer experience including coaching stints with the North Carolina ODP Program and the Region III ODP Staff.

COACHING DIRECTOR

Mark Brown is the former Head Coach at Dickinson College and played professionally in Scotland. He currently serves as the Head Coach for Penn State Harrisburg and has extensive experience coaching youth soccer.

BOYS CAMP

This camp is for boys between the ages of 10-18 who are serious soccer athletes with aspirations of some day competing at the collegiate level. Over the four-day camp the players will enjoy nine sessions designed to improve both their attacking and defensive play in an intense yet fun environment. The curriculum will be developed to expose the athletes to the technical and tactical concepts that are critical to their success. There will also be nightly full sided matches which will culminate with "Championship" matches on the final morning.

High School Team Program

We will tailor our training plan to address the team's special needs. We will work closely with the High School Staff to ensure that this week will have meaningful application to your upcoming season.

WHAT TO BRING

All players must bring a ball to camp (balls are available for purchase). If a ball is forgotten, one must be purchased.

- Training gear for all sessions, shin-guards.
- Cleats, sneakers, flip-flops, and swimwear.
- Bed linens, fans, and towels.

FACILITIES

The Boys Camp will utilize Clark Field and the adjacent varsity practice field for all sessions. Clark Field is the home venue for the Gettysburg College Soccer Teams and has a state of the art Field Turf surface, with seating for 600 and lights. The residents will live in a college dorm and be served all-you-can-eat meals in our excellent dining hall, which has received national recognition for the quality of their food. There will be opportunities to use the on campus swimming pool to relax and cool off.
