



## DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY

Dear Campus Community,

The Academic Fall 2009 semester, Gettysburg College will continue a number of established policies and initiatives related to student parking and transportation.

- **First-Year students are not permitted to park on campus**
  - To allow sufficient parking space for upperclass students, faculty, staff, and campus visitors
  - To help maintain a strong focus on the College community experience for our first-year students
  - Any requests for an exception must be submitted in writing to the Department of Public Safety. Approved exceptions will be permitted to park in the Stadium Lot- West.
  
- **The College has a shuttle service**
  - Providing the opportunity for students to travel from campus to Giant, Wal-Mart, and the local Outlet shopping/movie complex
  - The plan is to run the shuttle every Tuesday from 4-7pm, and every Saturday from 2-10pm
  - The college is also planning to run additional shuttles during the beginning of the academic year, as students are setting up their rooms. More detailed information about these additional shuttles when students arrive on campus.
  - The 11 person shuttle van will run on a continuous 30 minute loop during these hours, with specific pick-up/drop-off points both on campus and at each of the listed community locations.

- **All students parking on campus will be charged a parking fee of \$40 per semester**
  - These funds will go towards supporting the shuttle service, and towards improvements in parking quality, parking safety, and other campus transportation initiatives.
  - Students must register **EVERY YEAR** and obtain a **NEW PERMIT**.
  - Students who live off campus and will not be parking their vehicle on campus must register their vehicle with the College, but will not be

charged a fee. The Borough of Gettysburg requires all students to display a college parking permit.

- Commuter Parking Permits will also be available for \$20.00. A Commuter must reside outside the Borough of Gettysburg. Commuters will be restricted to parking in the Stone Parking Lot.
  - Student Registration will be available beginning August 1<sup>st</sup> 2009 by stopping in at Public Safety or accessing on line [http://www.gettysburg.edu/about/offices/college\\_life/safety/traffic\\_andparking.dot](http://www.gettysburg.edu/about/offices/college_life/safety/traffic_andparking.dot). Fees will be automatically charged to the student account. Permits will be sent to the student campus mail box.

- **The construction of the new Recreation Center has also caused some other changes for parking lot designations. Bream Gym will be closed the Fall Semester 2009 Academic Year. Stadium North Section will be designated for employees and visitors. Stadium South & West Sections are designated for student parking.**
