Your gift to any area of the College for the Cupola Society qualifies you for one of five levels of recognition, each named after a famous figure from Gettysburg's past:

Luella Musselman Paul (1910 – 1978) – For an annual gift of \$25,000 or above

Edward S. Breidenbaugh (1849 – 1926) – For an annual gift of \$10,000 to \$24,999

P.H. Glatfelter (1837 – 1907) – For an annual gift of \$5,000 to \$9,999

Harvey W. McKnight (1843 – 1914) – For an annual gift of \$2,500 to \$4,999

Samuel S. Schmucker (1799 – 1873) – For an annual gift of \$1,500 to \$2,499

Lifetime Cupola – Those members whose lifetime records of extraordinary support reach \$100,000 or more.
