



Assistant Professor of Music Education

The Sunderman Conservatory of Music at Gettysburg College seeks nominations and applications for an Assistant Professor of Music Education, Tenure Track, effective August 2010. Established in 2005, with a generous bequest from Dr. F. William Sunderman, Sr., an alumnus of the college, the Sunderman Conservatory prepares a broad array of musicians for musical leadership in a changing world through the integration of excellence in musical performance and the liberal arts.

Position Description – We seek a creative and dynamic music educator specializing in elementary/general music education. Primary teaching responsibilities include elementary music education methods, vocal/choral methods, and supervising/coordinating student teachers and field placements. Other assignments could include secondary music education methods, piano skills for music education majors, world music or conducting a choral ensemble. Additional contributions to the liberal arts mission of the College within the Conservatory will depend on the individual's strengths and Conservatory needs. The candidate will work among a collegial group of full-time and adjunct music faculty in active student recruitment and program building.

The successful candidate should possess a doctorate in music education (ABD considered with completion by August 2010). Other qualifications include a minimum of three years of successful music teaching in the public schools and a commitment to continued research, scholarship and creative activity. Preferred qualifications include one or more of the following: experience in teaching at the elementary and secondary levels, certification or substantial experience in the methodologies of Orff, Dalcroze and/or Kodály, experience in teaching world music education, certification or substantial experience in special needs education and/or bilingual music education, and experience using instructional technology, including electronic student portfolio assessment.

Application Process – Applicants should send a cover letter addressing the fit between their credentials and this position. Additionally, a *curriculum vitae*, three letters of reference, unofficial transcripts, and a sample syllabus should be sent. Please do not send videos or other materials at this time. Electronic applications will not be accepted.
