CENTER FORWARD: The Board of Trustees voted unanimously at its fall meeting to approve construction of the new Center for Athletics, Recreation and Fitness, while fund raising for the project continues. Groundbreaking for the \$25 million, 55,000-square-foot building to be located just west of Bream Gymnasium will be in May, 2008. Highlights of the Center will be a new swimming pool, weights and exercise equipment, a climbing wall, and multipurpose facilities for a variety of fitness activities. The main office of the 24-year-old EI is located in Washington, DC, and the mission of the organization remains to prepare successor generations to perfect the promise of the nation through engagement in distinctive programs of leadership and public policy.
