## Game Day Pavilion Rules

### **Respectful Environment/ Good Sportsmanship**

We want everyone to have a great experience. We ask that fans be respectful of those surrounding them, and remain mindful of their choice of language and activity. Individuals are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively on Gettysburg College. Persons acting in a disruptive, disrespectful, or disorderly manner will be asked to leave the premises or be subject to citation. Students also may be charged with a violation of the Student Code of Conduct. Please keep all music and audio at a volume that is respectful.

### **General Information**

- Game Day usage of the Pavilion located behind the West Building near the Quarry must be reserved by the Athletic Department.
- This area will be opened three (3) hours before the contest and will close two (2) hours after the contest.

### **Alcohol Consumption at the Pavilion**

- Groups intending to consume alcohol may do so ONLY at the Pavilion.
- Participants in such gatherings are expected to follow all relevant Pennsylvania laws and College policies, including not serving minors and not driving while intoxicated.
- Gettysburg College students may not be served or consume alcohol at Game Day events.
- Kegs are not permitted.
- Single cans only are permitted.
- Glass containers are prohibited.
- **No alcohol is allowed outside the Pavilion.**
- Alcohol may not be brought into sporting venues.
- Alcohol consumption is not permitted in cars in parking lots near the Pavilion.

### **Other Information**

- Animals must be kept on a leash.
- The College is not responsible or liable for accidents, damage, loss or theft of materials, items, or personal property.
- All other events must follow the College's social event policy.
