

2006-07 Gettysburg College Verification Worksheet

Financial aid officers will compare information reported on your 2006-07 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) with signed copies of your 2005 Federal Income Tax Return(s), W-2 Forms, and this Verification Worksheet. If there are differences between your FAFSA and the additional documents reviewed, corrections to your FAFSA will be submitted to the U.S. Department of Education. Additionally, any such corrections may also warrant an adjustment to any financial aid award that has already been offered for the 2006-07 academic year.

What you should do:

1. Complete this entire worksheet and SIGN. Please read each question carefully, they are the same as the FAFSA, so the answers should match.
