#### **Biography:**

Reuel Williams Waters of Augusta, Maine, was born October 31<sup>st</sup>, 1842, the fifth of six children to Cornelius Waters (1795-1880) and Abigail Irish (1806 – 1873). Waters had four sisters, Rebecca Irish Waters (1831 – 1882), Mary Louisa Waters (1833 – unknown), Abigail Cordelia Waters (1837 – 1877), Anna Gardner Waters (1851 – unknown), and one brother, James Cornelius Waters (1840 – 1870). Waters enlisted in the 6<sup>th</sup> Maine Light Artillery on November 11, 1862 at the age of 20, and was mustered out on June 17, 1865. The 6<sup>th</sup> Maine, also known as McGilvery's Battery, were engaged at 2<sup>nd</sup> Bull Run, the Wilderness, Spotsylvania, Cold Harbor, Petersburg, Opequan, Fisher's Hill, Cedar Creek, and Gettysburg. Waters married Emily A. Bently (October 6<sup>th</sup>, 1844 – unknown) with whom he had one child, Herbert Bentley Waters (September 12<sup>th</sup>, 1870 – unknown).

#### **Series Description**

The Reuel W. Waters Collection is divided into six Series. **Series I:** Biographical Information; **Series II:** Correspondence; **Series III:** Diary Manuscript; **Series IV:** Family Correspondence; **Series V:** Newspaper Clippings; and **Series VI:** Family Genealogy.

#### **Scope and Content Notes:**

This collection consists of three letters and a twenty-two page diary penned by Reuel Williams Waters. The diary manuscript is a 22 page quarto, titled "Diary from August 29<sup>th</sup> 1863 [corrected in pencil to 62] (Time of Enlistment into the U.S. Service) to January 1<sup>st</sup> 1864. Per Reuel Williams Waters." The letters are written by Waters to his sisters. Additionally, a photograph of Reuel Waters, several newspaper clippings concerning members of Waters' family and reunions of the 6<sup>th</sup> Maine Battery, letters penned by Waters' mother and sister-in-law after the war, and notes concerning Waters and Bentley (Waters' wife Emily Bentley) family genealogy are included in this collection. A transcription produced by the processor is included with each letter as well as the diary manuscript.
