OTHER CONSIDERATIONS

Choose 1: INTRODUCTORY COURSE

Choose one of the two available introductory courses. You may select the other as an elective, but be sure to include no more than <u>two</u> courses at the introductory level (courses numbered below 200).

Education 199: Foundations of Education Education 201: Educational Psychology

Choose 2: ADVANCED COURSES

Two courses must be taken at the advanced (300) level or higher.

Choose 3: ELECTIVES

Add any three additional courses as your electives.

OFF CAMPUS STUDY

One required elective may be taken off-campus in a program affiliated with the Center for Global Education or at an accredited college or university elsewhere in the U.S.

INTERDISCIPLINARY COURSES

Two courses may be taken in another department with the approval of your Education Advisor.

EDUCATION PROJECT

Educational Studies minors are encouraged, but not required, to consider completing an applied project or a research project in education.

DECLARING YOUR MINOR

Work with an Education Advisor to identify your program of study, then formally declare with the Registrar.
