Application Timeline	Public health school directly after Gettysburg College:  • Required courses completed by end of senior year (although preference may be given to applicants who complete the required courses sooner)  • Apply during fall of senior year
Standardized Test	<ul> <li>Usually Graduate Record Exam (GRE) revised General Test         (www.ets.org/gre), but varies by school</li> <li>Given year-round at computer-based test centers</li> <li>Length ~ 4 hours</li> <li>3 sections: Verbal Reasoning (score 130-170), Quantitative Reasoning (score 130-170), Analytical Writing (score 0-6)</li> <li>Register on-line (www.ets.org/gre)</li> <li>Free and low-cost preparation materials (www.ets.org/gre)</li> <li>Unofficial scores on test day, official scores in 10-15 days</li> </ul>
Application Service	<ul> <li>Schools of Public Health Application Service (SOPHAS)         (www.sophas.org)</li> <li>Available ~ September 1</li> <li>Schools not participating in SOPHAS: apply directly to school</li> <li>APPLY EARLY!!! Do not wait until application deadlines!</li> </ul>

Admissions Criteria	<ul> <li>GPA</li> <li>GRE scores</li> <li>Letters of evaluation</li> <li>Health-related experience</li> <li>Personal statement</li> </ul>
Length of Program	<ul> <li>Varies by school</li> <li>Master's programs ~ 2 years</li> <li>Doctoral programs ~ 3 – 5 years</li> </ul>
Degree	<ul> <li>Masters level: Master of Public Health (MPH), Master of Health Administration (MHA), Master of Science (MS), Masters Health Systems Administration (MHSA)</li> <li>Doctoral level: Doctor of Public Health (DrPH), Doctor of Philosophy (PhD), Doctor of Science (ScD)</li> </ul>
