Gettysburg College was founded on April 7, 1832, by anti-slavery theologian Samuel Simon Schmucker. Five years later, the institution (then known as Pennsylvania College) moved into Pennsylvania Hall, built on land provided by Thaddeus Stevens, whose illustrious career in Congress included authorship of the 14th Amendment, which guaranteed full civil rights to citizens of all states.

When the Civil War erupted, the College stood in its midst. Elements of two great armies swept through campus on July 1, 1863, the first day of the decisive Battle of Gettysburg. Pennsylvania Hall became a hospital for hundreds of soldiers from both North and South.

On November 19, 1863, townspeople, students, and faculty marched to hear President Abraham Lincoln hallow the National Cemetery with his *Gettysburg Address*. David Wills, an 1851 graduate, invited Lincoln to deliver “a few appropriate remarks.”

Almost a century later, President Dwight D. Eisenhower settled in Gettysburg after leaving the White House in 1961 and served on the College’s Board of Trustees. He wrote his memoirs in what is today the College’s Admissions Office.

Today, Gettysburg College is a vibrant learning community that has produced prominent graduates in a wide variety of fields, including former White House Counsel Fred Fielding ’61, U.S. Congressman Ron Paul ’57, Nobel Prize-winning cancer researcher Michael Bishop ’57, former NAACP President and CEO Bruce Gordon ’68, five-time Oscar-nominated cinematographer Owen Roizman ’58, Chair of the Global Partnership for Education Carol Bellamy ’63, Newbery Medal-winning *Maniac Magee* author Jerry Spinelli ’63, leading sleep researcher Mary Carskadon ’69, McKnight Foundation President Kathryn Wolford ’79, and Emmy-award winning actor, stylist, author, and fashion guru Carson Kressley ’91.

The Presidential Medallion

The Gettysburg College Presidential Medallion and chain were created in 1978 for the inauguration of Charles E. Glassick, the eleventh president, by Norman L. Annis, former professor of art. The medallion features the College seal, three inches in diameter. The seal is flanked by two smaller medallions, one being the seal of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America and the other depicting symbols of higher education. The one-inch medallions, which constitute the chain, list the past presidents and the dates they served the College.

The College Mace

Ceremonial occasions at Gettysburg College begin with the entrance of the College mace, carried by the College Marshal. The mace symbolizes the College's governing authority and is present only when the president is in attendance. It is used only at Convocation, the Midyear Graduates Recognition ceremony, the Baccalaureate service, and the Commencement ceremony.

The tradition of the mace derives from medieval England, when the mace was held by a bodyguard for dignitaries at ceremonial functions. As an ancient symbol of authority, it reminds us that the College is a custodian both of the enduring traditions of learning and of the power they bestow upon those who come to learn.

The Beachem Portico

The portico on the north side of Pennsylvania Hall is properly known as the Beachem Portico, erected with funds given by the Alumni Association and dedicated to the memory of the College's first alumni secretary, Charles W. Beachem 1925. Gettysburg College's Alumni Association is among the oldest in the nation and particularly notable for having been formed within three years of the 1832 founding of the College. The Alumni Association of Pennsylvania College (as it was then known) was founded on Commencement day, September 16, 1835. There were 11 initial members, the graduates of 1834 and 1835.

President's Chair

The President's Chair comes from the estate of Dr. F. William Sunderman Sr., a 1919 graduate of Gettysburg College. In 1983 he created the Sunderman Foundation for Chamber Music, which presents a concert series on campus each year. He was also a trustee emeritus of the College and the founder of its annual Henry M. Scharf Lecture on Current Affairs. Upon Dr. Sunderman's death in 2003, his legacy provided for the establishment of the College's F. William Sunderman Sr. Conservatory of Music, which began admitting students in the fall of 2006.

Stole of Gratitude

The "Stole of Gratitude," a tradition which originated in 2004, is in part a gift from the Gettysburg College Alumni Association and the President's Office. The graduates will wear the stoles throughout the Commencement Exercises as symbols of their appreciation for all of the individuals whose support was instrumental in bringing them to this day. At the reception following Commencement, or at some other time, graduates may present the stole to someone to demonstrate their gratitude for that individual's role in their success.

Academic Regalia

Academic ceremonies, with their gowns, mortarboards, tassels, hoods, and maces are colorful traditions handed down from European universities of the Middle Ages. The first organized institutions of learning took form during the twelfth and thirteenth centuries, generally under the jurisdiction of the church. Academic regalia, as we know them today, have evolved from the robes, hoods, and caps worn mainly for warmth in unheated buildings by the clerics, monks, and priests who were the first students.

While European universities continue to show great diversity in their academic dress, American universities, in 1895, adopted a code of academic uniformity. The colors, designs, and opulence used in the tassels, hoods, velvet and satin trimmings, and robes designate everything from the level of degree held by the wearer, to his or her field of study, to the institution from which the degree was earned.

Wendy R. Sherman

U.S. Deputy Secretary of State

**Commencement Speaker and
Honorary Degree Recipient**
Doctor of Public Service

Deputy Secretary Wendy Sherman has been a leading voice for diplomacy throughout her distinguished career in public service. From her earliest days as a social worker and Director of Child Welfare for the State of Maryland to her service at the State Department, Deputy Secretary Sherman has tackled some of the nation's most complex challenges.

As the second-highest ranking official in the State Department, Deputy Secretary Sherman works alongside Secretary of State Antony Blinken to formulate and conduct United States foreign policy. She is the first female Deputy Secretary of State in U.S. history, and she was the first female Under Secretary of State for Political Affairs from 2011 to 2015.

As Under Secretary of State for Political Affairs, she led the U.S. negotiating team that agreed on a Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action between the United Nations (U.N.) security council—China, France, Russia, the United Kingdom, and the United States—Germany, the European Union, and Iran.

Honoring all of her diplomatic achievements, Deputy Secretary Sherman was awarded the National Security Medal by President Barack Obama.

She previously served as Counselor under Secretary Madeleine Albright, Special Advisor to President Bill Clinton and Policy Coordinator on North Korea, and Assistant Secretary for Legislative Affairs under Secretary Warren Christopher. She sat on the President's Intelligence Advisory Board, chaired the Board of Directors of Oxfam America, and served on the U.S. Department of Defense's Defense Policy Board and Congressional Commission on the Prevention of Weapons of Mass Destruction, Proliferation, and Terrorism.

Prior to her current role, Deputy Secretary Sherman was director of the Center for Public Leadership at the Harvard Kennedy School and Professor on the Practice of Public Leadership. She was also a senior fellow at the Kennedy School's Belfer Center for Science and International Affairs, and a senior counselor at Albright Stonebridge Group.

Born in Baltimore and raised an hour south of Gettysburg, Deputy Secretary Sherman received a B.A. in sociology and urban studies from Boston University and a master's degree in social work from the University of Maryland. ■

John “Jack” Hewes is a recognized and respected industry leader in the fields of consumer-lending and finance. He held senior executive positions at MBNA America Bank where he pioneered the Bank’s consumer and small business lending products and Sallie Mae, which he helped transform from a government-focused business into the consumer-lending enterprise of SLM Corporation.

His tenacity and leadership were evident as a Gettysburg College parent, serving as co-chair of the Executive Board of the Parents’ Association; chair of the Parents Fund committee; and, subsequently, a member of the Board of Trustees from 2001-2004.

Hewes and his wife Nancy are members of Gettysburg’s Benefactors Circle, and their selfless and continued philanthropy has had a tangible impact on the College and its students over the years. Their committed support has covered a wide variety of integral operating areas of campus, including the Science Center; John F. Jaeger Center for Athletics; Recreation, and Fitness, Orange and Blue Club; Gettysburg Fund; and financial aid.

Throughout his professional career and in his personal life, Hewes has been known as a humble leader who is committed to the success of others. In addition to his service at Gettysburg College, Hewes served as national chairman of the Loyola College Parents Council and is an honorary board member of Big Brothers, Big Sisters of Delaware.

As a Gettysburg parent, he witnessed the value of a Gettysburg College education, and has continued to give generously to further the mission of the College. Characterized by a College leader as a “great talent combined with great humility,” Hewes never had the opportunity to earn a college degree, but his commitment and unwavering dedication to higher education has led to the bestowment of this honorary degree today. ■

Speaking on behalf of the Class of 2023 is Anna Benson ’23, who is from Lexington, Massachusetts. Benson came to Gettysburg to experience a myriad of leadership, service, and study abroad opportunities. She was drawn to the Center for Public Service (CPS), where she served as a program coordinator for a college preparation program for local first-generation high school students. As part of CPS, Benson also led a dozen students through an immersive educational trip to Morocco to learn about women’s rights and movements in the context of Islam.

Benson participated in various programs with the Eisenhower Institute, including Women and Leadership and Washington Summer Fellowship. During her fellowship last summer, she interned with Velocity Government Relations and tracked and analyzed policies important to national security, aerospace, and defense industry clients with a focus on artificial intelligence, hypersonics, spectrum, 5G, space policy, and military posturing.

Since her first year on campus, Benson has represented the Class of 2023 as a member of Student Senate. She also served as philanthropy chair and vice president of membership experience with Alpha Delta Pi and president of Sigma Iota Rho, the international studies honors society. During the fall of 2022, she was a coalition leader for the Gettysburg Votes Campaign, which sought to improve civic engagement on campus by educating and motivating students to participate in American democracy. Benson studied abroad in Mérida, Mexico, and she served as a peer learning associate for the Spanish Department.

Benson received the Linnaean Award from the Alumni Association and the Outstanding Community Partner Award from Greek Life. During Spring Honors Day, Benson was recognized with the Gettysburg College Senior Prize, which is awarded to a female senior who exemplifies commitment to community and concern for the welfare of others during the student’s years at Gettysburg College, and who shows promise of future accomplishment in support of community, state, and nation.

Following graduation, Benson plans to travel to Spain to work as a language assistant through the North American Language and Culture Assistants Program (NALCAP) with the Education Office of the Embassy of Spain. ■

Lavern H. Brenneman ’36 Award for Exemplary Volunteer Service to Gettysburg College

The Lavern H. Brenneman ’36 Award for Exemplary Volunteer Service to Gettysburg College is presented in recognition of those rare individuals whose distinguished service to Gettysburg College stands above others who have served the institution faithfully. For more than 50 years, Patricia W. Henry ’71 has been a loyal and dedicated supporter of the institution, all while serving as a prominent leader in higher education.

Henry served three terms on the Board of Trustees, spanning 1993 to 2007, and was elected as a Trustee Emeritus in 2010. Her leadership on the College’s Commission on the Future 25 years ago helped set the stage for many campus improvements, particularly for residential life and community well-being. She served on the Athletics and Recreation Facilities Committee, which led to the opening of the John F. Jaeger Center for Athletics, Recreation, and Fitness in 2010.

Recently co-chairing her 50th Reunion Committee, Henry has been an invaluable leader on campus committees. She provided key insight as a member of the National Campaign Steering Committee, Cupola Executive Committee, Campaign Executive Committee, the Orange & Blue Advisory Council, the Board of Fellows, and the Alumni Executive Board. Her philanthropic investment covers a variety of priorities, including endowed scholarship funds, athletic initiatives, and campus beautification.

Away from Gettysburg, Henry has been a change-maker and innovator in higher education. The former Senior Associate Director of Athletics at Harvard University, she was instrumental in the success and well-being of 42 intercollegiate varsity athletics programs, while advocating for broad-based programs and “Athletics for All.”

Henry, who retired from Harvard in 2019, was named to Gettysburg’s Hall of Athletic Honor in 1987 and the ECAC Hall of Fame in 2018. In 2022, she was awarded the Nike Lifetime Achievement Award from the Women Leaders in College Sports. At Gettysburg, Henry majored in health and physical education and played both field hockey and basketball. She earned a master’s in education from West Chester University in 1975. ■
