About the Band, Wind and Percussion Area in the Sunderman Conservatory of Music

The Wind Ensemble in the Sunderman Conservatory is the premier wind and percussion ensemble at Gettysburg College and is designed for the development of the professional performer, the professional educator and the dedicated musician. We are excited to announce that in 2009 this group will become the Wind Symphony and begin to present up to four concerts each year.

The Sunderman Chamber Winds is a small, flexible ensemble consisting primarily of wind players. This ensemble gives instrumental musicians an important chamber music experience that places responsibility on each individual. Membership in this ensemble is drawn from the Wind Ensemble.

Another new development in 2009-2010 is the creation of the Gettysburg College-Community Symphony Band. This ensemble will meet January-April on Monday evenings and perform traditional and modern literature for symphonic bands in one concert each spring. Membership is open to all Gettysburg College students and we also welcome wind players and percussionists from the college community as well as the greater Gettysburg area. There is no audition required for membership. If you are a student or community member interested in performing with this group in the spring of next year, visit our website for more information.

The 100-member Bullets Marching Band is one of the most visible musical ensembles at Gettysburg College and is a valued part of the Band, Wind and Percussion Area. The Bullets Band performs at all home football games, the Collegiate Marching Band Festival in Allentown (PA), high school exhibitions and regional parades.
