## **Gettysburg College Health Services: Medical information**

It is important to seek medical care after sexual assault due to risk of contracting sexually transmitted infections, possible pregnancy (if female).

Health Services is here to support and care for you.

Emergency Appointments Available: Monday – Friday 8:00am to 5:00pm

Please call 717-337-6970 (Option #1) and simply request an "emergency appointment." No further information needed or asked.

## Services offered "FREE OF CHARGE":

- Plan B, if female, and within 5 days of assault (120 hours)
- Sexually transmitted infection (STI) screening including: chlamydia, gonorrhea, trichomonas, syphilis, bacterial vaginosis, HIV (will be discussed with the provider at time of visit)
- **Prophylactic treatment** for STI-antibiotics given at time of visit; Hepatitis B immunization (if not already immunized)
- **Physical exam** (if indicated)
- Follow up care: 2 week follow up to retest for STI, 4 week follow up for retesting for pregnancy if Plan B taken
- Emotional Support: bridge to Counseling Services
