



With the Results, any drugs showing a status of “NF” are not covered on the formulary drug list. An alternative that you can talk to your doctor about may show below. While the Tiers showing do not have a direct correlation to your out of pocket cost, it is likely that the lower the Tier the lower total cost of the prescription, which does affect how much you pay.

Definition of Status

| Icon | Status | Definition |
|---|---------------|--|
|  | Tier 1 | Tier 1 Generic Drugs: typically have the lowest member cost share. |
|  | Tier 2 | Tier 2 Generic Drugs: typically have a higher member cost share than Tier 1. |
|  | Tier 3 | Tier 3 Generic and Brand Drugs: typically have a higher member cost share than lower tiers. Tier 3 includes standard brands and some generic drugs. |
|  | Tier 4 | Tier 4 Generic and Brand Drugs: typically have the highest member cost share. Tier 4 includes brand and generic drugs and specialty medications. |
|  | Non-Formulary | Non-Formulary Drugs are not covered on the formulary drug list. Coverage is not provided for prescription and over-the-counter drugs not appearing on the formulary drug list, unless an exception has been granted. |
