Definition of Status

Icon	Status	Definition
T1 Tier 1	Tier 1	Tier 1 Generic Drugs: typically have the lowest member cost share.
T2 Tier 2	Tier 2	Tier 2 Generic Drugs: typically have a higher member cost share than Tier 1.
T3 Tier 3	Tier 3	Tier 3 Generic and Brand Drugs: typically have a higher member cost share than lower tiers. Tier 3 includes standard brands and some generic drugs.
T4 Tier 4	Tier 4	Tier 4 Generic and Brand Drugs: typically have the highest member cost share. Tier 4 includes brand and generic drugs and specialty medications.
NF	Non-Formulary	Non-Formulary Drugs are not covered on the formulary drug list. Coverage is not provided for prescription and over-the-counter drugs not appearing on the formulary drug list, unless an exception has been granted.
