Note. ^aIf a student completed more than one major, he/she was counted within each major she/he completed in the GRAND TOTAL, but counted only once in TOTAL INDIVIDUALS (unduplicated count). *Classification of Instructional Programs (CIP) is a taxonomic coding scheme for secondary and postsecondary instructional programs. CIP Code is a six-digit code in the form xx.xxxx that identifies instructional program specialties. It is the accepted federal government statistical standard on instructional program classifications and is used in a variety of education information surveys and databases. CIP was originally developed by the U.S. Department of Education's National Center for Education Statistics (NCES) in 1980, with revisions occurring in 1985, 1990, 2000, and 2010. Reported in the table above is the two-digit level CIP Code.

**CIP code for Computer Science changed to 11.0701, starting from AY 2018-19.
