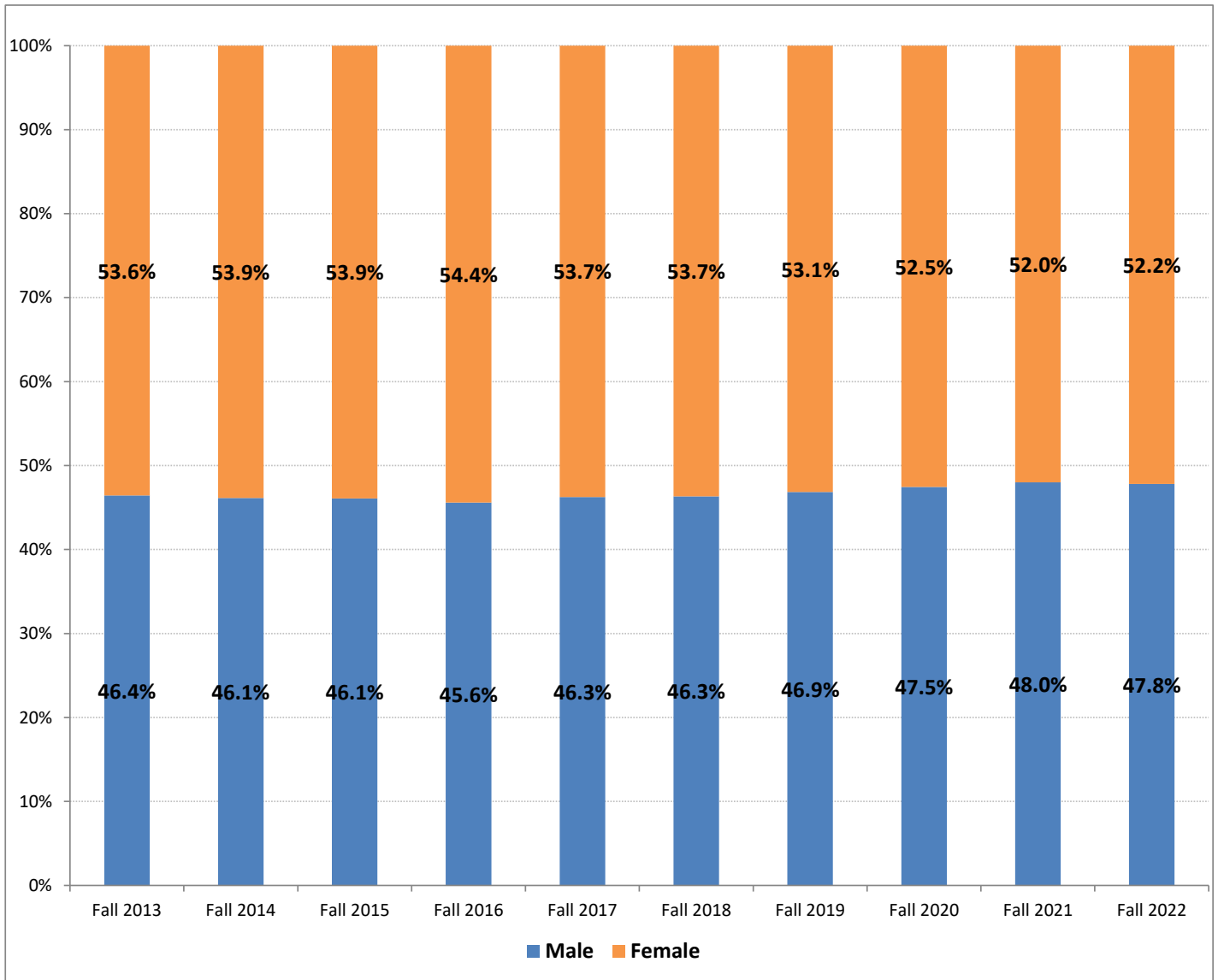

### Fall Total Undergraduate Enrollment: Female and Male Students in the Student Body



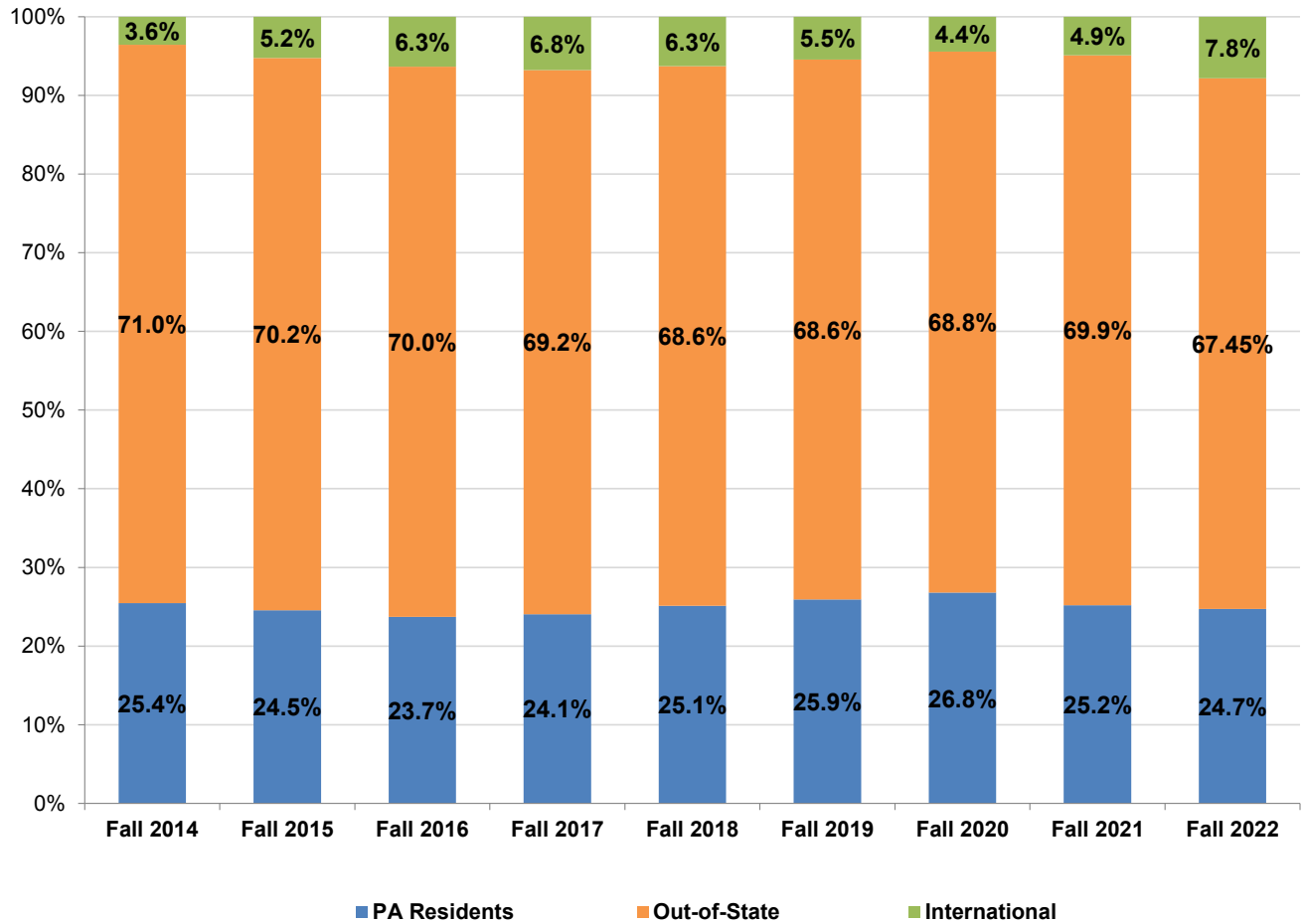

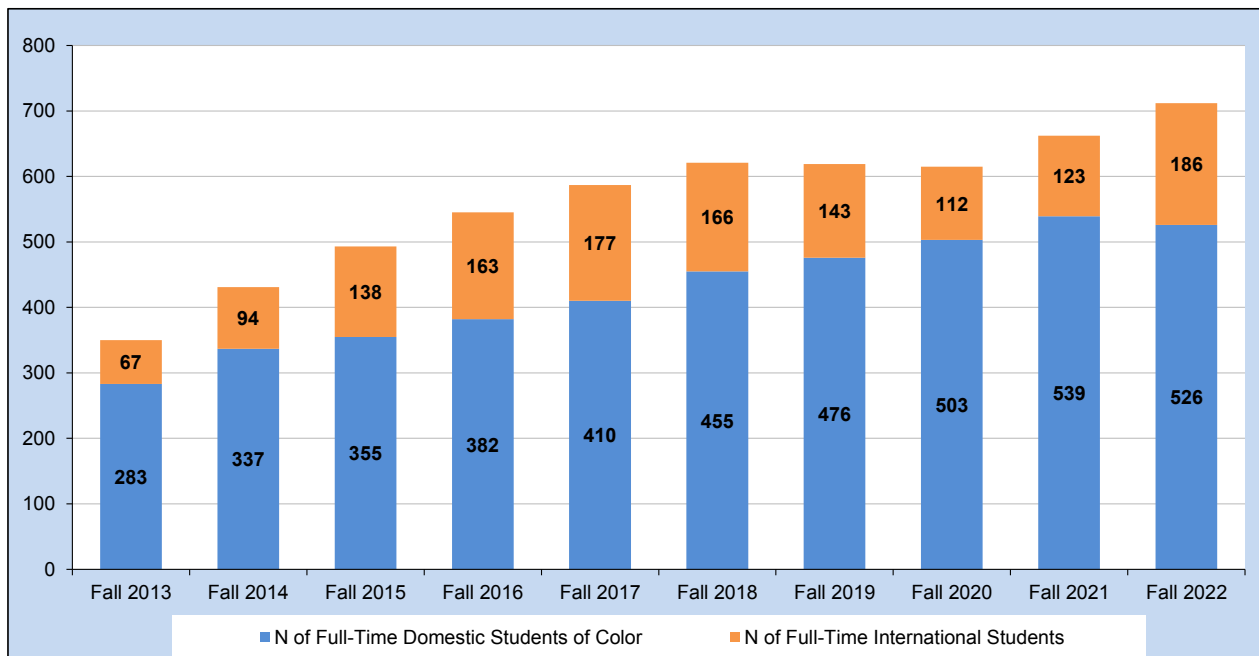
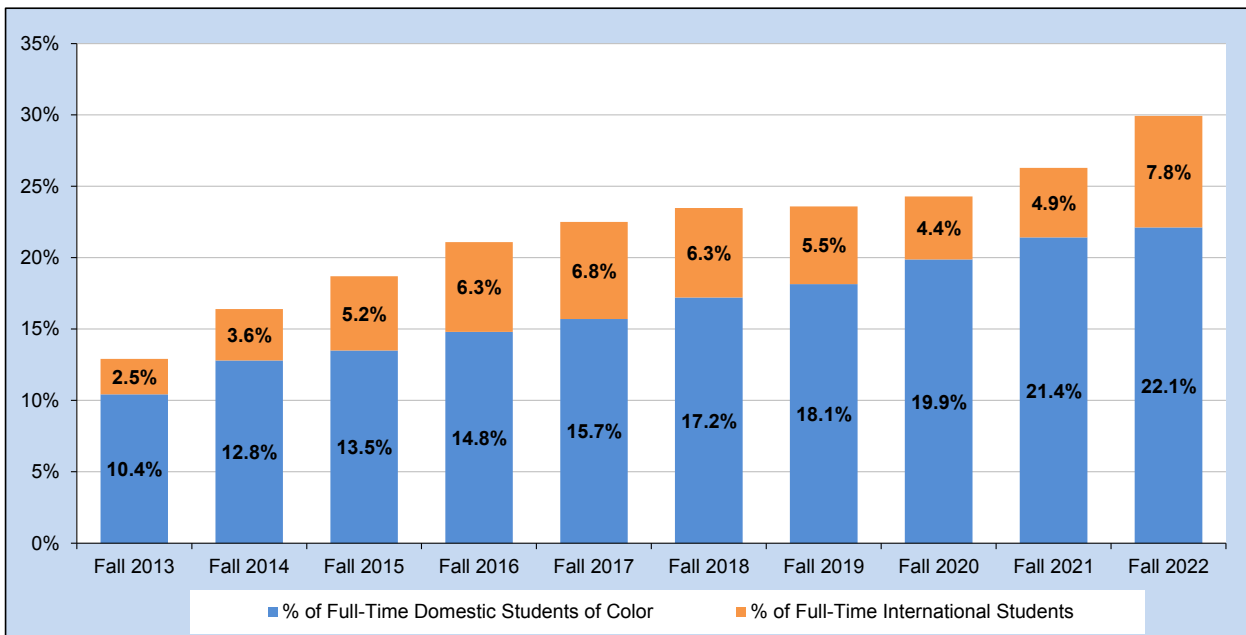
