Included in this report are the overall scores received by the fraternities and sororities at Gettysburg College based on the 2016 written reports, documentation and oral presentations delivered by the executive boards of each organization. These presentations and materials were reviewed by 8-member panels that represented various campus constituencies. The scores reflect the degree to which chapters are fulfilling expectations and in alignment with the goals set forth by Gettysburg College for its social fraternities and sororities. The grading rubric on which the chapters were scored had 500 total possible points.

Chapters with less than 10 members are scored through a different process to ensure standards are met.
