Gettysburg Asylum for Invalid Soldiers  
Incorporated by Act of Assembly  
Of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
Dated March 6<sup>th</sup> 1867  
First Disposition

This is to Certify that the holder has subscribed Five Dollars towards the erection of the above Institution and is entitled to such distributive share of the property of value and interest from association with the late war, or any moneys, effects, property or estate, real or personal, belonging to this Association, as shall be awarded to number.
