

**CWVFM-107: A. J. Zabriskie**

Most likely, this is Abram Zabriskie of the 9<sup>th</sup> New Jersey Infantry. This regiment fought in such major engagements as the battle of Roanoke Island (2/8/1862) and the battle of New Berne (3/14/1862). Zabriskie's letters seem to be a second-hand account of action at the battle of Gettysburg.

Letters to L.W. Allen from Zabriskie:

5/14/1896 (2): One of the letters deals with the Confederate assault on Cemetery Ridge, and the other mentions a "Council of War" that occurred on the 4<sup>th</sup> of July and a "Council of the Corps Commanders" on the 12<sup>th</sup>.
